<b>Timings</b>	<u>Practice</u> : 2 ends will commence immediately after assembly on both days. <u>Registration</u> : Registration will be open from 8am. <u>Assembly</u> : at 9:15am on both days.
<b>Awards</b>	Awards will be given each day for the bow styles competing on that day, 1-3 irrespective of entries.

<b>Rules</b>	World Archery rules will apply to this event.
<b>Bosses</b>	Layered Foam bosses will be used on H frame stands.
<b>Facilities</b>	Toilets on site in King's Pavilion, including disabled toilets, first aid kit available and drinking water in staff room in the pavilion. Catering: Hot food may be available and cold food will be available as well as drinks and a Bake Sale.
<b>Scoring</b>	Double scoring on paper will be used.
<b>Parking</b>	Parking is available onsite in the University Car Parks and on University Road, the parking inside the field gate is reserved for disabled participants and volunteers and can be accessed from Regent Walk.
<b>Lord Patron/Lady Paramount</b>	Michal Kozera, Chairperson of the SAA Northern Area Committee.
<b>Drugs etc...</b>	No smoking/vaping is permitted in front of the tent line and preferably not on the sports field at all. This event is liable for drug testing. Please bear this in mind.

**All archers of every ability and experience are welcome to enter this event. On the Sunday archers are welcome to shoot any distance they feel comfortable with. However if you want to be part of the championships then you need to shoot the age appropriate round. Please see the AGB rules of shooting.**

**Two longer distances will be on 122cm faces with 80cm faces for the two shorter distances.**

**Compound and recurve will shoot inner 6 ring faces at the shorter distances.**

**Longbow and Barebow will shoot full face for all distances**

**All ends will be 6 arrow ends.**

# **Disability Championship**

**Disabled: Members must have either a World Archery classification (National or International) or be a member who considers themselves to have a disability. Each classification may be split into Men and Women should numbers allow. Otherwise Men and Women will shoot together in each classification .**
